British troops were then stationed in Boston.

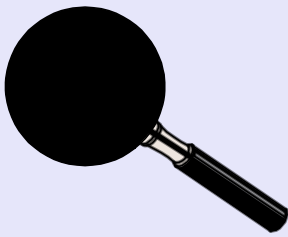


Five protesters were killed in the

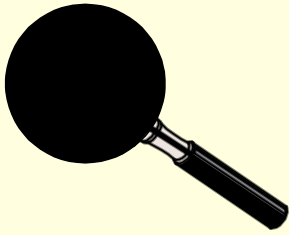

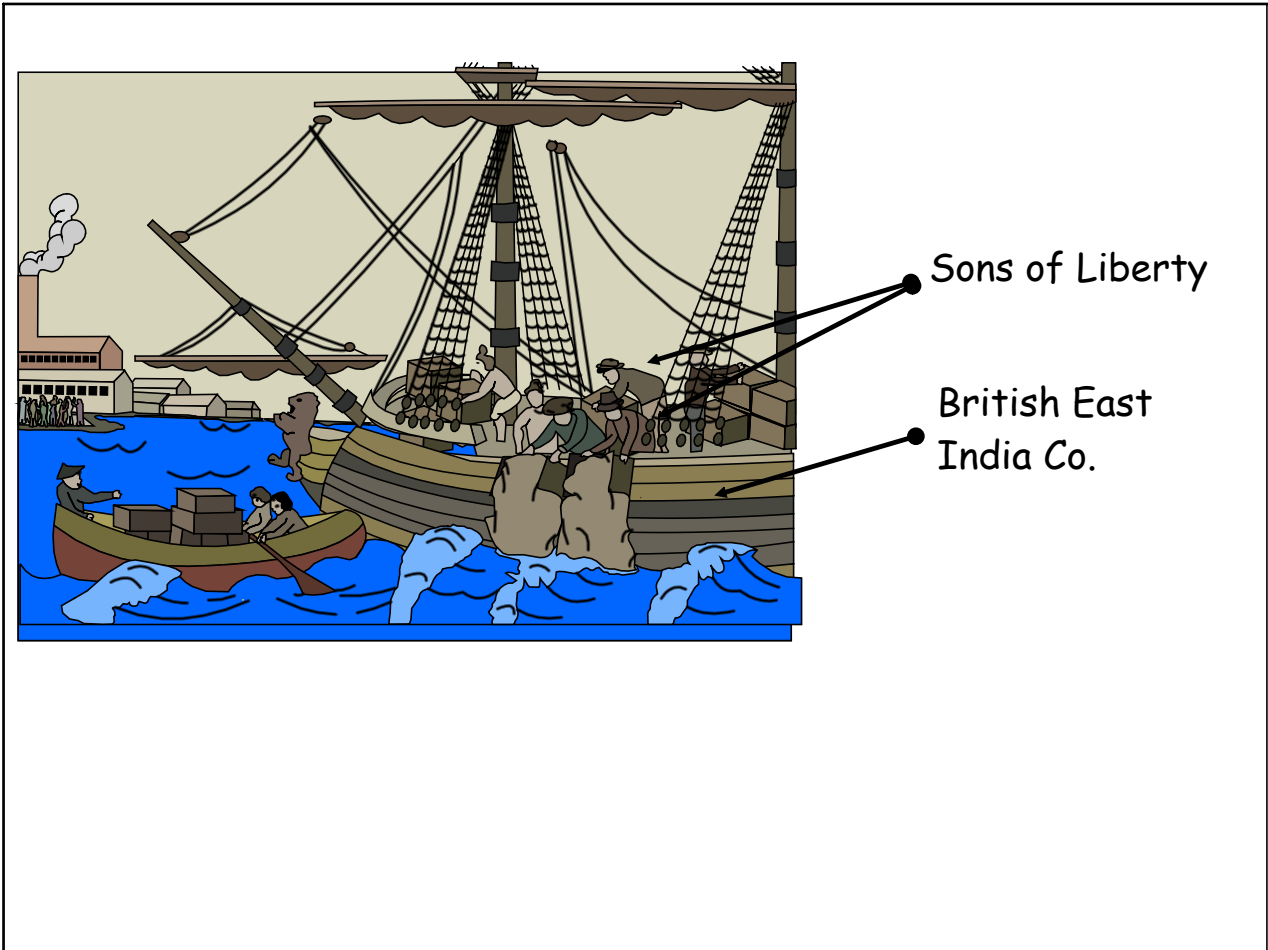

Intolerable Acts:

- 1) shut down the port of Boston until colonist paid for tea
- 2) town meetings were limited, as were legislative sessions
(limited their self- government)
- 3) English officials charged with crimes would be tried in England
(basically assured there would not be a “fair trial”)
- 4) Quartering Act
Colonists had to house British troops in their homes!

Led to the 1st Continental Congress.
Sent King George Declaration of Rights.
He refused this!
